TRANSITION PLANS & SERVICES ADHOC COMMITTEE MEETING (5:30pm)

With Amy Perez, Danielle Clark, Jody Bondurant-Strong, Sonia Picos, . CAC discussed progress for Transition Plan compliance review. Jody has been to 2 highschools so far. Appropriate PRT and other staff are assisting her. Amy reviewed TRACE program and expanded direction for flexibility and individualizing. Amy and Sonia discussed identified need for program options for students designated moderate/severe and/or medically fragile. Options currently are: in the community all day, staying at their highschool until 22, or developing an alternative site for a program. District is currently exploring and/or trying these solutions. Operation Success was reviewed. They have rolled out the program this semester. Teachers are hired and paraprofessionals are in process of being hired for all 7 school sites. Danielle shared that OS will address credit deficient 11th, 12th and 5th year+ students but remain flexible for student needs at each school site. Because of APEX limits with accessibility and A-G approval, district is exploring alternative online programs. CAC mentioned ALEKS Program as a possibility (which the district already uses).

SPECIAL DISCUSSION

<u>LCFF</u>: District will be developing a district-wide Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP), not for each school site. Input is being gathered from the community at the Vision 20-20 Forums. 8 priorities will be addressed in the plan. SDUSD receives funding under 3 categories: 1st bucket for all students. 2nd bucket for when 20% of students that are identified (low income, foster youth, English learners). 3rd bucket is concentration funds is for 55% students that are identified (low income, foster youth, English learners).

<u>Due Process</u>: CAC Exec Board requested information on trends in types of complaints for Due Process. District provided information on data from 7-1-13 to 2-22-14 for Grade, Ethnicity, and Federal Handicapping Condition. Themes/types of complaints are not tracked.
