**SUBJECT:** A regular report of the CCTE Online Project for the Office of College, Career & Technical Education for the period of June 2012 and September 2012.

**ITEMS:**

Project Update

- Cadre 1 courses launched on June 25: Marketing, Computer Applications, Business 100, Human Psychology and Family Sociology, and Anatomy and Physiology for Health Careers. Semester one of each course was taught. The courses had 21 total completers.
- First semester taught in pilot mode this summer. 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester tested and reviewed during summer.
- Cadre 2 courses semester 1 courses developed and ready for launch: Contemporary Communications; Introduction to Engineering and Design, Nutrition, and Video Production.
- Cadre 2 courses semester 2 being developed and tested in fall semester.
- Introduction to Criminal Justice Careers will be launched in spring semester. Currently the course is under revision.
- Ten total courses to be implemented during 2012-13 school year.
- Cadre 3 courses being identified for development during 2012-13 school year with pilot launch summer 2013.
- Marketing to military students and parents. Outreach to counselors and administrators implemented to increase course interest.
- Providing access to classroom teachers to blended learning versions of courses.

Challenges

- Course enrollments low due to following factors: staffing issues at start of school year impacting student schedules, counseling buy-in, and confusion on graduation requirements.
- Courses not UC eligible or meeting computer literacy requirement suffering from low interest/enrollment.

Next Steps

- Development of course delivery system district-wide.
- Interactive Professional Development course for online and blended models of elearning.
- Develop new models of online project based learning.
