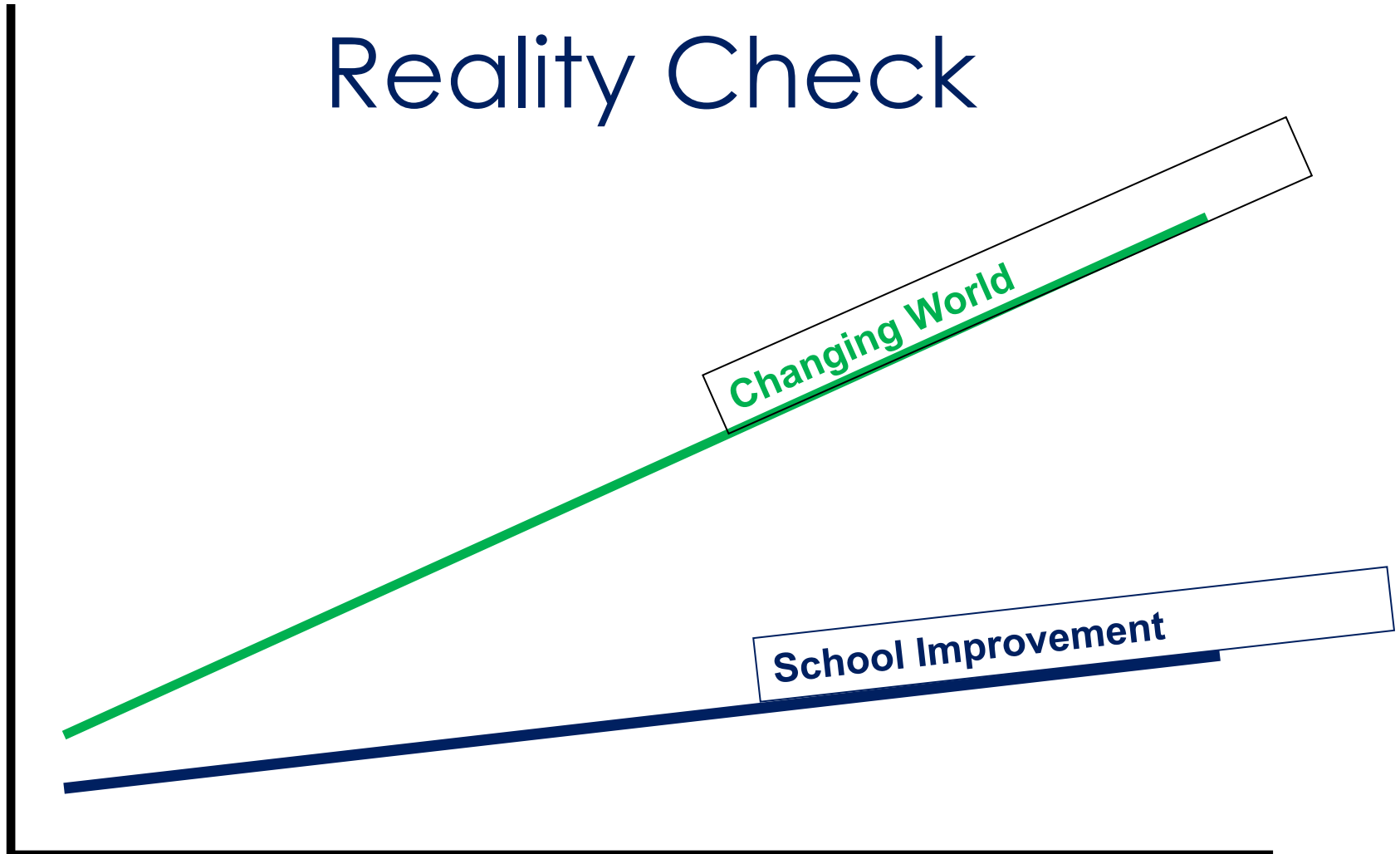


GSA 2.5 - Reasonable interpretation

 - Career exploration, correlation to academics, 48 mo-12th grade



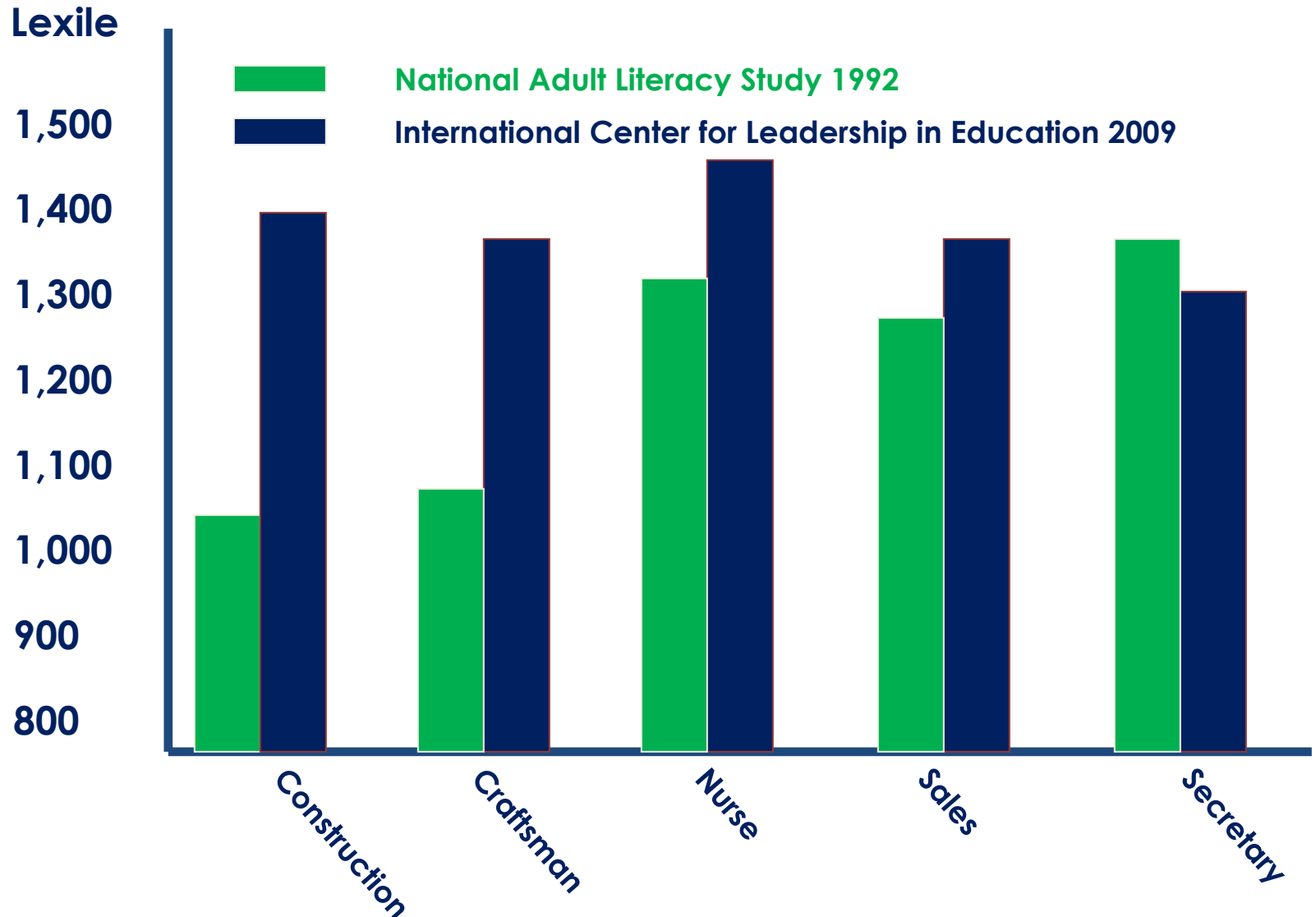

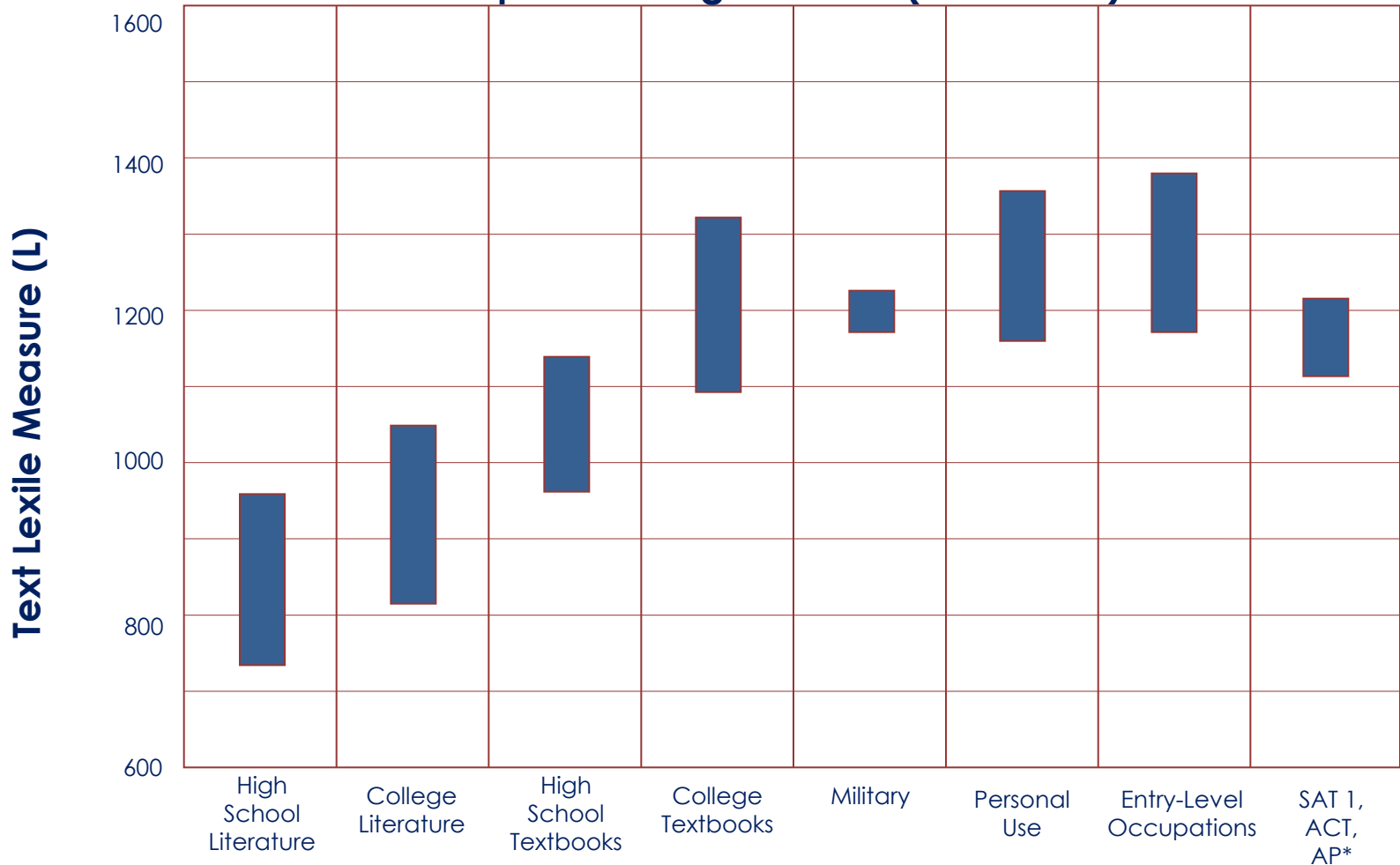
