#### **REASONABLE INTERPRETATION:**

#### Implementation:

- UC "a-g" approved course textbook list compiled. Publishers contacted to ascertain Lexile measurements.
- 54% response rate from publishers as of 3/28/13.
- Flesch-Kincaid measurements converted to Lexile measurements.

#### Findings:

- Average Lexile of CTE textbooks 1157
- Varies by industry sector
  - Business and Finance 1066
  - Health 1250
  - Energy 1291
  - Arts, Media and Entertainment 1096
  - Hospitality 960
  - o Education1102
  - Marketing 1100
  - Construction 1055
  - Environmental Science 1292
  - Public Service 1360
- Entry level occupations require approximately 1180-1380

#### **Action and Timeline:**

- Continue contacting publishers for additional information
- Identify gaps in literary measurements needed for college and career
- Analyze information text used in courses outside of textbooks
- Periodically monitor and report progress
