

Charter School Capital Facility Funding Request for Project (Bixby, Durfee)

Charter School Community Project Outreach

- The development of a charter school project outreach process would:
 - Provide a method to develop an understanding from the entire charter community on what type of projects would have the most impact on improving charter school student choice and student performance.
 - Provide an initial understanding of what the anticipated need for funding from charter schools within the district will be over the short term and long term
 - Provide specific examples of proposed projects that might need legal opinion or analysis to be considered and funded in the future
 - Allow for Committee recommendation of projects that can be funded more expeditiously without controversy, legal issue or district staff process concerns
 - Allow the committee to identify proposed projects where the charter school or leader needs additional assistance to plan and provide the necessary documentation for future funding

- Qualifications and Required Information
 - Charter School Name - Contact
 - Term of Charter School Petition
 - Dollar Amount of Total Project
 - Dollar Amount Requested (from Proposition Z)
 - Description of Project:
 - Project is on District Property/Public Property/Private Property/Leased Facility/Owned Facility
 - Type of Project: Maintenance, Planning, Lease, Construction, Non-construction, Portable Purchase, etc.
 - Description of what planning/design has been completed

Timeline

- August 2013 - Letter to all San Diego Charter Leaders – August 1
- August 2013 – September 30, 2013 - receive Request for Project information from charter leaders
- October 2013 – CSFC to begin discussions on submitted projects
