Zickert explained what the equitable services were.</li> <li>Equitable participation is monitored and enforced by the CDE through the Ombudsman's Office during Federal and Program Monitoring audit.</li> <li>Discussion ensured on the process used by the district to determine the number of eligible students receiving equitable services at private schools.</li> </ul>
