#### **Quality Neighborhood Schools: Enrollment**

- ► Family Welcome and Enrollment Center opened August 2016 to provide more information on neighborhood schools
- ▶ Major media coverage with seven televised interviews
- Since opening, serves an average of 3,000 families each month in person, via email, and on the telephone
- Promotes clusters and neighborhood schools by streaming site videos and photos highlighting successful programs
- ► Assists sites with self promotion








#### Quality Neighborhood Schools: Providing 1:1 Customer Service

#### Quality Neighborhood Schools: Choice Application Window

- October 3 through November 14: six weeks
- 11,000+ Choice applications received, exceeding prior years' numbers
- Fewer late applications, likely due to the robust information campaign

- 8. Develop a strategic marketing plan.
- 9. Online Learning: Study Escondido Union High School District and other exemplary models for Independent Study, Credit Recovery, and College and Career Counseling.
- 10. Re-design the Neighborhood Schools and Enrollment Options Office and review functional policies.
- 11. Review transportation policies.


