Preparing for May 27 DELAC Presentation to Board of Education

Officers discussed several topics for the presentation including maintaining ELST positions with supplemental EL funds from the LCFF and presenting the "promising practice" of the Academic Language Development (ALD) course to meet the needs of Long Term English Learners. DELAC recognizes that the work of the Board of Education is closing the achievement gap and DELAC's concern is more specifically for closing the achievement gap for English Learners. It was agreed that Valentina would approve the draft of the presentation.
