Rode addressed the following items: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – CAASPP assessment system replaces the Standardized Testing and Reporting (STAR) Program. – Field test of the consortium (i.e., Smarter Balanced) summative assessment for English-Language Arts (ELA) and mathematics in grades three, eight, and grade 11. The operational Smarter Balanced test in 2015 will be a computer adaptive test. Questions will change based on the response of the student. – There will be no student level results. Therefore, there are no results to send to parents in the fall. There will be no school API for 2 years (Elementary/Middle). High schools will have an AYP measure because it is based on the CAHSEE test. – The field test will examine the questions, assessment levels, technology requirements, etc. Data from the field test will be used to assign performance levels. Additional details about the field test can be found in the Smarter Balanced Field Test Questions and Answer page Smarter Balanced Field Test Questions and Answer page. • Rode reported the BOE has selected the DELAC and DAC parent advisory group for the parent input on the LCAP (Local Control Accountability Plan).
