# **Emerging Business Enterprise (EBE) Awards for Capital Bonds Projects**

To date, EBE construction bid awards for 2015 total \$21,111,622 or 36.11% of total construction awards. Please refer to the Business Outreach Report, Construction, 2015, 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter table for further detail.
