Memorial Preparatory for Scholars and Athletes: April 15 and 23; May 12 and 20. Henry High School: April 16 and 30; May 14. The final plan will be presented to parents, neighbors, staff and students at 6 p.m. on May 21.

The final plans for each of these sites will be presented to parents, neighbors, staff and students at the end of these work sessions. The Board Office will be notified when those meeting dates are set.

Subject: Long-Range Site Master Plan Meetings

San Diego Unified School District is developing a long-range site master plan for your school as part of its district-wide Long-Range Facilities Master Plan. The site master plan provides a road map for the near- and long-term growth and redevelopment of your school campus. It will also assist in planning the Proposition S projects for your school.

Input from parents, neighbors, school staff and students is vital to the success of this site master planning process. Therefore, we would like to invite you to participate in the planning sessions listed below.

The purpose of the long-range site master plan is to outline a logical, phased development or redevelopment of a campus, maximizing the site's potential to meet the long-term goals of the school while best utilizing currently available funds. A long-term vision relating to the educational goals and community needs of each school will be used to develop a conceptual site layout that considers both short- and long-term needs.

The process for developing the school's site master plan will consist of approximately four sessions, with representation from all school stakeholders. At the first meeting, there will be a presentation explaining the purpose for a school's long-range site master plan and the process for development. After the initial meeting, there will be approximately three work sessions to develop the site master plan.

Participating representatives are requested to make a <u>commitment to attend all work</u> <u>sessions</u> for plan development consistency. It is also requested that participants be committed to the development of a global long-term vision for the school. The process will focus on a general site plan concept and will not include details of specific projects. There will be an opportunity to provide input on specific Prop. S projects via a separate Design Task Force process. After the site master planning process is complete, parents, neighbors, staff and students will be invited to attend a presentation of the plan.
