RE: **Annual Employee Notifications- 2020-2021**

The Annual Employees Notifications process is the District's method to provide all District employees the notification of their obligations in relation to the topics listed below.

Employees must also acknowledge their receipt of this information via an electronic acknowledgement. The SafeSchools online platform will be used to provide employees with the required training and/ or policy review. Board Policy, State and Federal law require the following mandated trainings and/ or policy review training for all employees of the San Diego Unified School District.

Employees will receive an email from "**San Diego Unified School District, Subject: SafeSchools Online Training.**" The email will provide log in instructions and the link to the training and/ or policy review.

- The training and/ or policy review can be completed all at once or in small sessions. The employee will receive email reminders until they have complete the training and/ or policy review.
- When employees complete a training and/ or policy review, they have the option to print a certificate. This is not required.
 - Employees may present the certificate, if requested, at the site or department level.
 - **Do not send the certificates to the HR office**, we will be monitoring completion electronically and do not need the paper documentation.
