



## **Pathway to Biliteracy Award Frequently Asked Questions**

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### ***What is the “Pathway to Biliteracy Award?”***

- Students will be recognized for their commitment to continue developing two or more languages.

### ***Is there a cost?***

- There is no cost incurred by students who receive the Pathway to Biliteracy Award.

### ***Does a student’s GPA matter?***

- Students in grade 8 must maintain a minimum overall grade point average of 2.0 in order to receive the Pathway to Biliteracy Award.

### ***Do English learners need to be re-designated as English proficient speakers?***

- No, however students must demonstrate progress in acquiring English. Please see requirement 1 on the application for further details.

### ***Does a student’s current dual/biliteracy/world language teacher need to approve the application?***

- The student’s dual/biliteracy/world language teacher does not need to approve the application. However, it is expected that the dual/biliteracy/world language teacher will monitor students’ progress and provide appropriate supports and interventions to ensure that the student continue to progress in the target language and that students in 8<sup>th</sup> grade maintain an overall grade point average of 2.0 or higher.
