Request for K-9 Sniff

This form is for a District middle or high school that desires to have a random dog sniff conducted on their school grounds. In order to conduct such a sniff, the middle or high school principal shall complete and submit this request form to the School Police Services Department for review and approval. If approved, the School Police Services Department will determine whether to utilize its own canine unit or a qualified contracted vendor or other law enforcement agency.

Be advised that dog sniff is an extension of an administrative search and will be conducted randomly for narcotics. Sniffs may be performed on student lockers; unattended automobiles in school parking lots; and empty classrooms when students have left the classroom and have left personal belongings in the classroom.

Dog sniffs may not be performed on the person of a student; on backpacks, purses or other personal items on a student's person; and students cannot be directed to leave a classroom and leave their personal belongings in the classroom for a dog sniff.

Dog sniffs can be an effective tool in reducing the opportunity for students to be in contact with illegal drugs.
