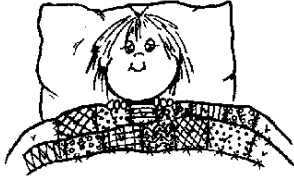

Course of Action

Symptoms

Fever measured orally is **above 100.5°**



Vomits more than once



Infrequent diarrhea



Ear infection; no pain



Minor cold: runny nose, cough, sneezing, sore throat



Infestation of scabies, lice



(After treatment begins)

Cold sores



(Sore covered)

Strep throat



(After 24 hours of medication)

Undiagnosed skin rash



Eye infection



Flu: body aches, fever, headache



Vague "I don't feel good" symptoms
