ALBA's student population is transient, students stay at ALBA no more than a semester, for this reason meetings/workshops for parent groups are not a feasible way to involve parents but administration, counselors, nurse, therapists and teachers make every effort provide a flexible schedule for parents to participate in their children's education, also parents are referred to outside agencies for extra support on topics not covered during enrollment at our site. ALBA will make an effort to communicate the following topics on an ongoing basis.
 - ❖ Improving communication between the school and home (via phone calls, letters and school messenger)
 - ❖ Discussing current student assessment data and student progress
 - ❖ Providing information about school and district resources for student academic improvement
 - ❖ Conferencing with teachers
 - ❖ Refer parents to outside agencies to help them support and work with their children at home and at school (Parenting Classes, Health Education, Mental Health Education and referrals)
 - ❖ Discussing the importance of consistent and regular student attendance including mentorships and incentives
 - ❖ Advocating for teachers and parents
 - ❖ Valuing cultural diversity
- Every attempt is made to communicate/contact parents in their primary language.
- During parent meetings, opportunities will be offered for the formulation of parental suggestions. Responses for their suggestions will be reviewed in a timely fashion. Topics that are appropriate for SSC review/action will be placed on the agenda for the next regularly scheduled meeting by the school administration.
- Parents are notified annually of individual student assessments results by the Research and Reporting Department and the Testing Department. An explanation of the information is available in several languages.
