TRIPLE E nominations are now being accepted from Patrick Henry High School students in all grades who have exhibited **Excellence, Ethics, and Enterprise** in the community. **This non-monetary award is specifically for volunteering and community involvement.** The program is intended to recognize students who may not necessarily be involved in student government, athletics, or other student body activities. Awards have been given for (but are not limited to) achievements in various girls' and boys' organizations; expression of care and concern for humanity, animals, and the environment; bravery; patriotism; and all manner of volunteer work and contributions to the community. The student's citizenship record will be reviewed; a "U" in citizenship this school year will automatically disqualify the student.

Nominations may be submitted by organizations, parents, community members, and staff until the **deadline on Friday, May 4, 2018.** The award committee will review applications and notify the award recipients by May 18. The selected students and their parents will be invited to a **reception on June 7 at 7:45 AM** in the PHHS library. Refreshments will be provided and each student will be recognized for their achievements and presented a certificate.

A minimum of two nominations is required, one of which must come from the organization for which the student volunteered. Achievements and volunteer work must be verified in a letter by the nominee's supervisor or other adult to whom the student reports. The supervisor's letter should be on the organization's letterhead, stating the dates and times of service (*i.e., Tuesdays and Thursdays during January and February from 3-4:30 p.m.*) and describing the achievement or volunteer work the student performed.

Each candidate must also submit a 400-word essay describing their contributions to the community through volunteering, and explaining what they have learned or experienced through volunteer work.
