VERIFICATION OF STUDENT ACCESS TO ELECTRONIC INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS



Every school in the district is required to provide "Sufficient" instructional materials for all students in the core subject areas of mathematics, English Language Arts, history/social science and science (plus health and world language for grades 9-12). Each pupil including English learners, must have a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home. This does not mean each student will be issued two sets of instructional materials, only one set to be used for both home and in class.

At iHigh Virtual Academy, all core subject area courses (plus health and world language courses) have the instructional materials embedded within the online courses. The courses are available online to use on campus or at home, from any Internet-connected computer. The only courses that include required print-format textbooks are the Advanced Placement courses. Students will be issued the appropriate texts for their Advanced Placement courses, to use on campus or at home.

Students may request to check out a printed format copy of the district-adopted text, if they would like to do so as a supplemental resource. The online and print-version materials are both aligned to state standards but may not follow the same scope and sequence in presenting the content.

Taking courses via online independent study is a voluntary option. Students may request to return to a traditional seat-based program at their school of residence (or other available school of choice) at any time.
