The San Diego Promise is a two-year completion program designed to ensure students complete their educational goal whether it be to earn a certificate of completion and enter the workforce, complete an associate degree, or transfer to a university.

PROGRAM BENEFITS

- Individualized support to help you complete your education goals
- Assigned Peer Mentor/Success Coach
- Individualized counseling and guidance support
- Priority consideration for transfer to SDSU

**Students who meet program requirements in their first year may be eligible for free tuition in their second year*

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a California resident for tuition purposes or AB 540 eligible

- Must complete a 2019-2020 FAFSA or Dream Act application

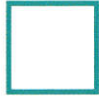
PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Attend an on-campus Promise orientation
- Sign a Promise contract
- Enroll in at least 12 units by September 3, 2019
- Meet with a counselor each semester
- Complete a Personal Growth course in the first year
- Complete a comprehensive education plan by the end of the first year
- Maintain a 2.0 or higher grade point average

GET STARTED— Complete steps 1-4 by **June 28** for priority registration and admission to the program



STEP 1:

Complete a Fall 2019 Admissions application to City, Mesa, or Miramar College at www.sdccd.edu/future-students/admissions



STEP 2:

Complete a 2019-2020 Financial Aid (FAFSA) or Dream Act application at fafsa.ed.gov or dream.csac.ca.gov

STEP 3:

Complete a Promise application for your campus at:

STEP 4:

Complete an online orientation, English and math placement assistant, and meet with a college counselor for an abbreviated education plan.



STEP 5:

Attend an on-campus Promise orientation and sign your Promise contract.
