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Course Description

Our textbook is called Integrated CME Project Mathematics III. The focus of the Mathematics III course is on quadratic expressions, equations, and functions, statistics, sequences, and series, trigonometry and complex numbers. It will build upon topics from Mathematics I and II. This course includes standards from the conceptual categories of Number and Quantity, Algebra, Functions, Geometry, and Statistics and Probability (from *California Common Core State Standards: Mathematics*). Students will strive to achieve both Common Core content standards (what we know and are able to do) and practice standards (how we do it).
