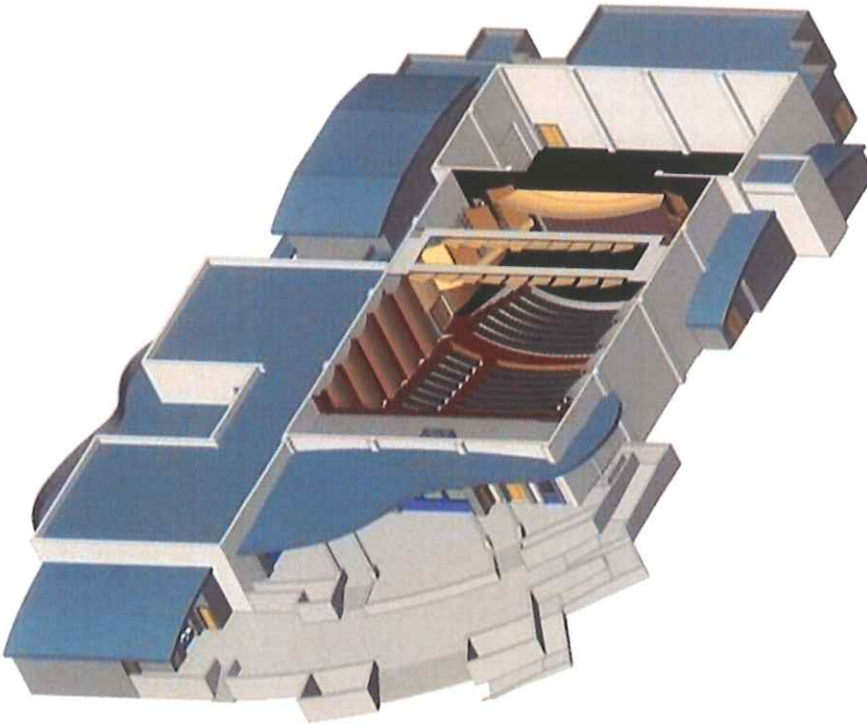


CPMA Middle School Proposition S



Summary

- Whole-site modernization and construction of performing arts center began fall 2012
- Nearly 60 percent complete as of August 2013
- Forecast completion is spring 2014
- Approved change order rate is 2 percent
- A nearly \$20 million investment that will benefit CPMA and the Clairemont community

The Creative Performing Media Arts Middle School, located at the former Kroc Middle School site in Clairemont, is getting a new state-of-the-art performing arts center that will benefit the school as well as the community. The campus is also undergoing a whole-site modernization. Below are the details for each project.

Performing Arts Center (\$11.6 million) – The construction of a new 20,600 square foot performing arts center at the east side of the CPMA campus includes a 400-seat theater, two music classrooms, scene shop, green room, control booth, ticket booths, restrooms, support and storage spaces.

Whole-Site Modernization (\$8.1 million) – Facility improvements are also in progress at CPMA. Key features include:

- Remodeling 300 building to support Special Education program
- Remodeling 500 building to support Visual and Performing Arts (VAPA) curriculum
- Adding a new dance studio to 800 building
- Expanding the existing dance studio in 400 building
- Remodeling existing restrooms
- Remodeling the food service facilities to include new serving area and kiosk
- Installing a new security fence and improving landscaping along the street in front of the school
- Making improvements needed to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act and current building codes

Both projects are possible because the San Diego voters approved Proposition S in 2008.
