Title I identified students (targeted assistance) eligible to receive services is based on allocation not actual Title I dollars, only services provided. Zickert explained what the equitable services were. Equitable participation is monitored and enforced by the CDE through the Ombudsman’s Office during Federal and Program Monitoring audit. <p>Discussion ensued on the process used by the district to determine the number of eligible students receiving equitable services at private schools.</p>
