

Article III. Officers

DELETE last sentence on first paragraph. No need of recommendation letter.

DELETE: Removal of Officers. Add: Replacement of Officers

- a. If the Chairperson position becomes vacant, the Vice-Chairperson shall become the Chairperson.
- b. If the Vice-Chairperson is unable, a special election shall be held immediately.
- c. In the event a Vice-Chairperson position becomes vacant, the Chairperson will appoint a member of the DELAC that meets the vice chairperson requirements to complete the term. The appointment must be ratified by the general DELAC body at the next general DELAC meeting.
- d. Any officer failing to fulfill the duties of the office may be suspended by a 2/3 majority vote of members present at the meeting in which the motion is made. The suspended officer may be removed from the office by a 2/3 majority vote of the members present at the next scheduled meeting.

Article VIII Amendment Process. DELETE ALL

Add: AMENDMENTS TO THE DELAC BYLAWS

- a. Thirty days notice of any proposed bylaws amendments shall be given to the DELAC membership.

Proposed changes to the bylaws may be made by the bylaws committee or any member of the DELAC.

A two-thirds (2/3) affirmation vote of the DELAC members present at the meeting. We must post the thirty (30) days' notice to amend the bylaws.

- b. The Bylaws in no way supersede the established State and District guidelines and regulations.
- c. The DELAC bylaws must be reviewed every two years at a minimum by the Executive Board
- d. The DELAC bylaws committee meetings will be publicly noticed.
- e. The DELAC bylaws will be translated into Spanish.
- f. Any DELAC member can propose an amendment to the Bylaws during the New Business portion of a duly noticed meeting for review and consideration pursuant to the process described within the Bylaws.

Also include that the bylaws can be changed at any time throughout the year.

Also include that proposed changes to the bylaws can be made in October, February and May by Board members or DELAC representatives especially during emergency times such as dealing with District Deficits that can affect all stakeholders (especially English Learners and their parents).
