Audubon's Support Teachers will either push in or pull out to assist GATE students who are struggling in English Language Arts and/or Math. Site Grade Level and Audubon's Support teachers are in the process of compiling grade level binders with collected data, current and ongoing assessments. Site also utilizes Professional Learning Communities to analyze intervention data for our students who are performing below basic in all subject areas. Students who are enrolled in our Primetime After School Program receive 2 hours per week of enhanced instruction by site certificated teachers.

Audubon provides a balanced curriculum for our students identified as GATE. Students are supported socio-emotionally as they build their capacity for empathy, self-awareness, ethical behavior, and community is a major consideration. Our curriculum is differentiated to offer each student opportunities to explore with depth, complexity, novelty and acceleration in each content area. It is the mission of Audubon Elementary to create a school community that empowers life-long learners through communication, cooperation and respect for diversity.
