

CONCEPTS AND ROLES

The Board of Education shall ensure that:

1. All schools are clean, safe, and well-organized and have a positive climate that supports the academic, emotional and physical needs of students through appropriate supervision, positive behavior intervention and support and customer service.
2. All students have equitable access to a broad and challenging curriculum, aligned to California/common core state standards, that engages them in inquiry, critical thinking and creativity and provides them with a strong foundation in the academic disciplines, broad exposure to the liberal arts and opportunities to pursue individual interests.
3. Every school is strongly committed to maintaining high expectations for all students and to eliminating persistent disparities in achievement and performance among student groups based on race, ethnicity, language or disability.
4. All schools reach out to parents as partners in their children's education and provide parents with the information necessary to know whether their sons and daughters are on-track to success.
