

FEE FOR TRANSPORTATION (FFT)

The Board of Education has retained the fee for transportation (FFT) policy for school bus service. The annual transportation fee is \$500 for the first student and a discounted fee of \$250 for the second student, with no additional cost for three or more riders in the same household. New pupils who qualify for school bus service must complete an application for transportation service during the enrollment process at the school site. Students with Special Needs with transportation as a related service in their IEP or students who qualify for Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) are exempt from the transportation fee (per California Ed Code Section 39807.5).

A Fee for Transportation letter and invoice is sent to the parents of affected students in August of each school year. If you did not receive this letter and require that information, you may download the current [FEE FOR TRANSPORTATION LETTER here](#).
